In your role as a volunteer, you must be treated and treat others with dignity and respect, free from harassment and bullying. You should always consider whether your words or conduct could be offensive. Even unintentional harassment or bullying is unacceptable. Bullying and/or harassment is a serious matter and incidents will be taken very seriously by WRAS. This apples to bullying and harassment by WRAS' volunteers and staff and also by third parties.
